

Cereal Box Book Report

Students will select a book appropriate to their reading level. The book should be challenging, but interesting. It is recommended that students use post-its to identify characters, favorite passages, and other interesting information. The goal of the book report is to encourage others to read the book.

1. Front: Name of the book, author's name, and illustrator 15 points
2. Top: "Sentence without an end" This sentence will compel others to read this book. 5 points
3. Bottom: purchasing information (bibliographic reference and price) 5 points
4. Right side of the box: genre 5 points
5. Left side of the box: favorite passage with explanation 10 points
6. Inside: An object that symbolizes something important to the story. 5 points
7. Back: Summary of the book and a description of the characters. 15 points
8. Neatness: Cutting of paper to cover the box should be well done. 10 points
9. Writing: It should be error free and in complete sentences as required. 20 points
10. Creativity: Student work shows effort, problem solving, and design. 10 points

Much of the work on this is to be done by the student at home. Time will be provided in school for this as well; students are expected to have their books with them at school until their presentations are made. Book reports will be brought to school on November 3. Presentations will begin that day; more specifications for the oral presentation will follow.
