Explanation of a Six-Level Rubric

6	"This level of performance is the truly exceptional ; everything about the project is impressive ; the student has exceeded the requirements of the assignment that the student has spent an extraordinary amount of time to complete the work."
5	"This level of performance is strong ; the work is above-average ; the project exceeds to some extent the requirements of the assignment; the required skills displayed are commendable ; care and effort are shown in the completion of the work."
4	"This level of performance is average ; the project meets all the requirements of the assignment but does not extend beyond ; the required skills displayed are adequate ; reasonable care and effort are shown."
3	"This level of performance is below average ; deficiencies in the project exist; the assignment is incomplete ; the required skills displayed are inadequate ; the project lacks care and effort ."
2	This level of performance is unacceptable ; important requirements for the project are missing or unfinished ; the work is careless ; little evidence of the required skills can be found; the project is poorly done .
1	"This level of performance is deficient ; none of the requirements for the project are complete; the work shows no care ; no evidence of the required skills can be found; the project is undone ."
